



Nationwide were extremely excited to be awarded the 'Fit-out' package upon this 'Citylabs' (formerly the Royal Eye Hospital) development in central Manchester which was a mixture of mix of old and new, original and modern, brought together beneath an overhead glazed roof creating a spectacular atrium.

Along with various elements of the refurbishment of the Grade II listed façade of the original building, specifically the 'Heritage Room' which included matching highly bespoke & centuries old Timber Panelling, over-boarding existing timber floors with new and the refurb of the existing hardwood Handrails in the original entrance.

Within the new building we supplied and installed our more standard Joinery items such as Doors, Frames, Architraves and Ironmongery sets, new W.C. Cubicles, Duct Panels and Vanity Units completed with ceramic tiles that we undertook as additional works, as well our more sundry items, we completed our works by installing Riser and Sliding Doors, 'Moveable' Walls and the insertion of 7' foot feature doors into individual office screens.
